Ezekiel 28:13-14

“You were in Eden, the garden of God. Your clothing was adorned with every precious stone — red carnelian, pale-green peridot, white moonstone, blue-green beryl, onyx, green jasper, blue lapis lazuli, turquoise, and emerald— all beautifully crafted for you and set in the finest gold. They were given to you on the day you were created. ¹⁴ I ordained and anointed you as the mighty angelic guardian. You had access to the holy mountain of God and walked among the stones of fire.”

Walking among the stones of fire is intimate relationship with God and access to His glory. The holy mountain of God has God’s presence.

Text: Ephesians 1: 18-21

- ¹⁸ I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know:
- a. the hope to which he has called you, the riches of His glorious inheritance in His holy people,
 - b. ¹⁹ and His incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength ²⁰ He exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly realms, ²¹ far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come.

vs 19 says we get access to His incomparably great power. That power is the same as the mighty strength He exerted when He raised Christ from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly realms.

We must note that when this power comes and delivers you, it immediately raises us above our enemies (vs 21).

Brethren, some take aways are key for us to understand from this scripture.....

1. The starting point to getting this power is believing (having faith) that it exists. Jesus

believed in the incomparably great power of God when He said to the Jews (John⁴ 2:19) “Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.”

2. The Jews did not believe it. So, their response (Matthew 27:62-66):

⁶² the chief priests and the Pharisees went to Pilate. ⁶³ “Sir,” they said, “we remember that while He was still alive that deceiver said, ‘After three days I will rise again.’ ⁶⁴ So give the order for the tomb to be made secure until the third day. Otherwise, His disciples may come and steal the body and tell the people that he has been raised from the dead. This last deception will be worse than the first.” ⁶⁵ “Take a guard,” Pilate answered. “Go, make the tomb as secure as you know how.” ⁶⁶ So they went and made the tomb secure by putting a seal on the stone and posting the guard.” The Jews thought the war will be carnal.

3. BUT “The weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds.” (2 Corinthians 10:4).

4. The incomparably great power of God came down, broken open the grave, released Jesus and raised Him above His enemies.

Matthew 28: 1-7 “¹.... Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to look at the

tomb. ²There was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven ⁵and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it. ³His appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow. ⁴The guards were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men. ⁵The angel said to the women, “Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. ⁶He is not here; he has risen, just as he said.

5. Brethren, No matter the challenge or situation, **Do Not Fear, Have Confidence In God.**

“blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord, whose confidence is in Him (Jeremiah 17:7). **The incomparably great power of God will break the tomb open, deliver us because He has set us above our enemies.**

Ephesians 2:6 says, “And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus.” This means that as believers in Christ, we are spiritually resurrected alongside Jesus and seated in a position of authority in the heavenly realm, superior to any earthly power or dominion or problem.

Conclusion: Everyone walking among the stones of fire is in Christ’s procession. Jesus will never leave us. He will never forsake us. Let us trust in the incomparably great power of God as we walk & work with the Holy Spirit to achieve what God has mapped out for us.
