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Part 20: Keep The Fire Burning

Text Leviticus 6:12-13

¹² The fire on the altar must be kept burning; it must not go out. Every morning the priest is to add firewood and arrange the burnt offering on the fire ¹³ The fire must be kept burning on the altar continuously; it must not go out.

Brethren, in the world, many things come up that come to challenge our faith. Things that potentially make us question our believe, our prayers, our faith. But God says in all, we must **keep our altar fire burning**. This is likened to the command of working out our salvation with fear and trembling (Philippians 2:12-13).

Proverbs 29:16: When the wicked thrive, rebellion increases; but the righteous will see the downfall of the wicked.

Matthew 24:12 “¹²Because lawlessness is increased, most people’s love will grow cold, ¹³but the person who stands firm and endures to the end will be saved

Brethren, although within our human capacity, our experiences, encounters, lived mishaps, and disappointments seem to be enough justification for loosing faith, being sloppy or fainting in zeal, the bible provides cautions and warning signs that help us understand God's views and position in such situations.

For instance:

Isaiah 55:8-9: ⁸“For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways,” declares the LORD. ⁹“For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so My ways are higher than your ways and My thoughts than your thoughts.

That tells us that God is not thinking at the level we are thinking.

Isaiah 40:31 “Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; But those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint. It tells us we must rise.



Jeremiah 12:5: “If you have raced with men on foot and they have worn you out, how can you compete with horses? If you stumble in safe country, how will you manage in the thickets by the Jordan? Tells us we must pick up new strength.

Part 20: Keep The Fire Burning

Taken together, God wants us to Keep Our Fire Burning, no matter what we have gone through, seen or experienced.

Example of ordinary people who kept their fire burning

Mark 15: 33-40- The Death of Jesus

³³ At noon, darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon. ³⁴ And at three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, “*Eloi, Eloi, lem sabachthani?*” (which means “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?”)

³⁷ **With a loud cry, Jesus breathed his last.**

⁴⁰ Some women were watching from a distance. Among them were Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James the younger and of Joseph, and Salome. ⁴¹ In Galilee these women had followed him and cared for his needs.

You can imagine the pain for these women who have lost someone they cherished so much and under the circumstance and age at which Jesus died.



Although they were very devastated, these ordinary women choose to **Keep Their Fire Burning.**

Mark 15: ⁴⁶ So Joseph bought some linen cloth, took down the body, wrapped it in the linen, and placed it in a tomb cut out of rock. Then he rolled a stone against the entrance of the tomb. ⁴⁷ **Mary Magdalene and Mary the mother of Joseph saw where he was laid.**

Mark 16:1- 7 “¹When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might go to anoint Jesus’ body. ²Very early on the first day of the week, just after sunrise, they were on their way to the tomb ³and they asked each other, “Who will roll the stone away from the entrance of the tomb?” ⁴But when they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had been rolled away. ⁵As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side, and they were alarmed. ⁶“Don’t be alarmed,” he said. “You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him. ⁷But go, tell his disciples and Peter, ‘He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.’”



These women who choose to Keep Their Fire Burning despite the disappointments became the people that God used to announce the resurrection to the likes of Peter who became dismayed due to the awful experience of Jesus’ death. **Brethren**, God’s ways are different from our ways, no matter the situation, let us **keep our fire burning**.
