Part 21: Surrounded by God's Power

Several scriptures affirm that **God's power surrounds us**. For example:

Psalms 125:2 "As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the Lord surrounds his people both now and forevermore".

Psalms 34:7: "The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear him, and he delivers them".

Psalms 139:5: David says, "You hem me in behind and before, and you lay your hand upon me."

Psalms 32:7: David says, "You are my hiding place; you will protect me from trouble and surround me with songs of deliverance

Psalms 12:5 God said "I will protect them from those who malign them."

God surrounds us to: protect us, equip us, empower us and keep us till the day of Jesus Christ.

Even in **1 Corinthians 2:9, God says:** "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love Him."

Matthew 13:16-17 "But blessed are your eyes because they see, and your ears because they hear.

For truly I tell you, many prophets and righteous men longed to see what you see but did not see it, and to hear what you hear but did not hear it.

Jeremiah 33:3 Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.'

Brethren, God's power that surrounds us is a treasure. If you have a treasure, you guard it with diligence.



Part 21: Surrounded by God's Power

God guards His “surrounding us with power” very jealously (Deut. 6:15 - for the LORD your God, who is among you, is a jealous God), ensuring that only those who qualify get that privilege. Although it is available to everybody, each person needs to qualify to get it.

2 Chronicles 16:9 “For the eyes of the LORD roam to and fro over all the earth, to show Himself strong on behalf of those whose hearts are fully devoted to Him. You have acted foolishly in this matter. From now on, therefore, you will be at war.”

Hebrews 12: 1-2 “¹Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off every encumbrance and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with endurance the race set out for us. ²Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.



Like Jesus, who's enduring the cross was not easy, God has not promised that we running the race will be easy, but He says it requires endurance and the sum what we go through will be gloriously positive (Roms 8:28). Glorious because, in Jesus' case, the end was glorious because He not only finished but became the Name above all names.

Part 21: Surrounded by God's Power

Surrounded by God's power, Christians are required to:

1. live a circumspective life: Example

In 1 Samuel 13:13, Samuel said to Saul, “You have done a foolish thing”, “You have not kept the command the LORD your God gave you; if you had, He would have established your kingdom over Israel for all time.”

Ephesians 5:15-16 Paul admonishes Christians to: “¹⁵ See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, ¹⁶ redeeming the time, because the days are evil.”

In Living a circumspective life, in 2 Samuel 24:10, after David had numbered the troops (which was against the will of the Lord), his conscience was stricken and he said to the LORD, “I have sinned greatly in what I have done. Now, O LORD, I beg You to take away the iniquity of Your servant, for I have acted very foolishly.”. When you make mistake, acknowledge it and ask for forgiveness right away.

2. be strong and very courageous

Joshua 1:7: God said to Joshua, “Above all, be strong and very courageous. Be careful to observe all the law that My servant Moses commanded you. Do not turn from it to the right or to the left, so that you may prosper wherever you go.”

3. run our Christian race with zeal in such a way as to take the prize

In Philippians 3:13-14, Paul said, Brothers, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize of God's heavenly calling in Christ Jesus.
