## Ezekiel 28:13-14

<sup>13</sup>“You were in Eden, the garden of God. Your clothing was adorned with every precious stone — all beautifully crafted for you and set in the finest gold. They were given to you on the day you were created. <sup>14</sup>I ordained and anointed you as the mighty angelic guardian. You had access to the holy mountain of God and walked among the stones of fire.”

**Walking among the stones of fire (walking in Christ’s triumphal procession) keeps our intimate relationship with God and gives us access to His glory. We become guiding light to others, as shown through our words, action and behaviour.**

**2 Corinthians 2:14-15** “<sup>14</sup> Thanks be to God, who always leads us as captives in Christ’s triumphal procession and uses us to spread the aroma of the knowledge of Him everywhere. <sup>15</sup> For we are to God the pleasing aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing.”

TEXT: Psalm 29:2

**“Give unto the LORD the glory due to His name; Worship the LORD in the beauty of His holiness.”**

**Brethren, we are** on Eagles’ wings, walking among the stones of fire and in Christ's triumphal procession.

**Have we ever wondered how others who had traveled the same path did it?**

- How did they give to God the glory due to Him?
- How did they worship God in the beauty of His holiness?
- What lessons can we learn from them?
- Which of the lessons can I/You personally adopt and implement?

**Example 2: Solomon (2 Chronicles 1 - 6)**

Similar to God carrying us on Eagle’s Wings (for reasons known only to God), God Selected Solomon to fulfil the promise He made to David: “<sup>17</sup>David will never lack a man to sit on the throne of the house of Israel (**Jeremiah 33:17**). ‘I have sworn to David My servant’, ‘I will establish your offspring forever and build up your throne for all generations.’ (**Psalm 89:3-4**). ... *how did Solomon worship God in the beauty of His holiness?*

**How did Solomon worship God in the beauty of His holiness?**

### **2 Samuel 7: 4-14**

<sup>4</sup> .... the LORD came to Nathan, saying: <sup>5</sup> “Go and tell my servant David, ‘This is what the LORD says: ....<sup>6</sup> I have not dwelt in a house from the day I brought the Israelites up out of Egypt to this day. I have been moving from place to place with a tent as my dwelling. ... <sup>12</sup> ..., I will raise up your offspring to succeed you, your own flesh and blood, and I will establish his kingdom. <sup>13</sup> He is the one who will build a house for my Name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. <sup>14</sup> I will be his father, and he will be my son. .... <sup>15</sup> ... my love will never be taken away from him,... . <sup>16</sup> Your house and your kingdom will endure forever before me your throne will be established forever.’”

**Brethren**, Solomon was carried on Eagles' wings by the Lord.

**how Solomon worshipped God in the beauty of His Holiness.**

### **1. Humility (started with his father David 2 Samuel 7:18-)**

<sup>18</sup> Then King David went in and sat before the LORD, and he said: “Who am I, Sovereign LORD, and what is my family, that you have brought me this far? <sup>19</sup> And as

if this were not enough in your sight, Sovereign LORD, you have also spoken about the future of the house of your servant—and this decree, Sovereign LORD, is for a mere human!

**Humility: Solomon sowed in appreciation of what God had said/done**

### **2 Chronicles 1: 6-12**

<sup>6</sup> Solomon went up to the bronze altar before the LORD in the tent of meeting and offered a thousand burnt offerings on it. <sup>7</sup> That night God appeared to Solomon and said to him, “Ask for whatever you want me to give you.”

<sup>8</sup> Solomon answered God, “You have shown great kindness to David my father and have made me king in his place. <sup>9</sup> Now, LORD God, let your promise to my father David be confirmed, for you have made me king over a people who are as numerous as the dust of the earth. <sup>10</sup> Give me wisdom and knowledge, that I may lead this people, for who is able to govern this great people of yours?”

<sup>11</sup> God said to Solomon, “Since this is your heart’s desire and you have not asked for wealth, possessions or honor, nor for the death of your enemies, and since you have not asked for a long life but for wisdom and knowledge to govern my people over

whom I have made you king, <sup>12</sup> therefore wisdom and knowledge will be given you. And I will also give you wealth, possessions and honor, such as no king who was before you ever had and none after you will have.”

### **2. Action: Championing the assigned specific Task**

#### **2 Chronicles 2**

<sup>1</sup>Solomon gave orders to build a temple for the Name of the LORD and a royal palace for himself... <sup>3</sup> Solomon sent this message to Hiram king of Tyre: ... <sup>5</sup> “The temple I am going to build will be great, because our God is greater than all other gods. <sup>6</sup> But who is able to build a temple for him, since the heavens, even the highest heavens, cannot contain him? Who then am I to build a temple for him, except as a place to burn sacrifices before him?

#### **2 Chronicles 3**

<sup>1</sup>Then Solomon began to build the temple of the LORD in Jerusalem...<sup>2</sup> He began building on the second day of the second month in the fourth year of his reign.

----- *(People on Eagles’ wings embark on specific task on specific known date.)*

## 3. Unwavering Faith

### 2 Chronicles 5

<sup>1</sup>When all the work Solomon had done for the temple of the LORD was finished, ...

<sup>2</sup>Then Solomon summoned to Jerusalem the elders of Israel, all the heads of the tribes and the chiefs of the Israelite families, to bring up the ark of the LORD's covenant from Zion, the City of David. <sup>6</sup> King Solomon and the entire assembly of Israel that had gathered about him were before the ark, sacrificing so many sheep and cattle that they could not be recorded or counted..... <sup>10</sup>There was nothing in the ark except the two tablets that Moses had placed in it at Horeb, where the LORD made a covenant with the Israelites after they came out of Egypt.... <sup>14</sup> the glory of the LORD filled the temple of God.

Brethren, Solomon had unwavering faith in the Lord.

### Conclusion

**Last week** we saw how Abraham consistently built alters and worshiped God along the way. **Today**, we see how Solomon through Humility, Action and Unwavering faith worshipped God.
